
PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE that responses if any, to the proposed First Omnibus Objection (the "Responses") shall be made in writing, shall conform to the Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure and the Local Rules for the Southern District of New York, shall state with particularity the grounds upon which such Response is based, and shall be filed with the Bankruptcy Court, in electronic format in accordance with General Order M-399, by utilizing the Court's electronic case filing system at [www.nysb.uscourts.gov](http://www.nysb.uscourts.gov), or if the same cannot be filed electronically, by manually filing same with the Clerk of the Court together with a cd-rom containing same in Word, Wordperfect or pdf format, with a hard copy provided to the Clerk's Office at the Bankruptcy Court for delivery to the Chambers of the Honorable Robert D.
