AMENDED ORDER GRANTING THIRD OMNIBUS OBJECTION TO CLAIMS

An Order having been entered on May 7, 2015 in connection with the Plan Administrator's Third Omnibus Objection to Claims (the "Third Objection") (i) partially granting the Third Objection and (ii) partially withdrawing the Third Objection [Docket No. 1064] (the "Third Omnibus Order"), all as more fully set forth in the Third Omnibus Order; and the Debtor having thereafter been advised that Claim No. 966, filed on behalf of Enid Wright on September 13, 2013, had been timely filed and was thus improperly included on Exhibit A to the Third Omnibus Order; and the Debtor having reviewed the Claims Register in regards to Claim No. 966 and having concluded that Claim No. 966 was timely filed; and good and sufficient cause appearing to amend the Third Omnibus Order under Fed. R. Bankr. P. 9024 to correct such error, it is hereby

ORDERED, that the Third Omnibus Order is hereby AMENDED as follows and otherwise shall remain in full force and effect:

1. Claim No. 966 is hereby removed from the list of expunged and disallowed claims as set forth on Exhibit A to the Third Omnibus Order, without prejudice to the Debtor's rights to object to the merits of the underlying claim.

2. Except as modified herein, all of the remaining terms and conditions of the Third Omnibus Order shall remain in full force and effect.

3. The Debtors' claims and noticing agent, Garden City Group, LLC, and the Clerk of this Court are authorized to take any and all actions that are necessary or appropriate to give effect to this Order; and it is further

4. This Court shall retain jurisdiction over any and all issues arising from or related to the implementation and interpretation of this Order.
