I am writing this letter in hopes of making it known to your office how important it is for me to receive the \$25,000 investment we entrusted to the Woodbridge Group investors in December 2016.

My husband and I were able to invest that \$25,000 into Woodbridge Group because we sold our small condominium. We couldn't stay there any longer because my husband's health was declining with diabetes and congestive heart failure. He couldn't negotiate the many steps up to our second floor unit. Due to our limited funds, we have had to rent in a senior apartment complex with an elevator.

Last December, my husband died of esophageal and stomach cancer. Before he died, he was glad to know that I had the Woodbridge investment to help me through my senior years ahead (I'm 71 years old). He died on December 10. Ten days later, I received the first letter dated December 13 regarding the Woodbridge Group of Companies Chapter 11 proceedings. Needless to say, I was devastated! Not only would I no longer be receiving the \$208 interest check every month, but our whole investment was now at risk.

I have sent the "Proof of Claim" form back that was requested; however, most of the other notices of the case I've received are either somewhat repetitive or confusing. I trust that I've done whatever was necessary in response.

I don't know if your office can do anything to ensure the return of my \$25,000 investment, but if so, I would greatly appreciate whatever you can do. I have written this honestly and with hope in my heart that all will come to a positive ending.
