As we interpret this document, we believe that the Bankruptcy Court is attempting to seize some or all of our retirement funds as penalty for investing in the Woodbridge Company a few years ago.


Needless to say, we are very concerned. We are in our late seventies and early eighties and the funds you refer to are our 401 K retirement funds. They represent 60+ years of hard work, scrimping and saving and to lose our money would be devastating to us.

Your letter identifies me as a defendant. I don't understand what I am defending myself against. A few years ago, at the advice of my financial advisor, I simply invested funds in what appeared to be a legitimate company. (Woodbridge) Obviously, if I had had any knowledge of Woodbridge's pending bankruptcy, I would not have invested with them. A few months later when they failed to meet the terms of our agreement, I withdrew my funds. I still had no knowledge of a pending bankruptcy. I can't see where I did anything illegal, unethical, immoral, unfair or wrong in any way. That is my defense.

I hope our country is not in such a mess that an honorable, loyal, hardworking American citizen can have his life savings attacked in this way.

I hope you can understand the stress and anxiety this is causing us. I will appreciate it very much if you will keep me informed as much as possible as to these proceedings. Thank you very much.
