ORDER, PURSUANT TO SECTIONS 105(a), 363, AND 503 OF THE BANKRUPTCY CODE, AND RULE 9019 OF THE FEDERAL RULES OF BANKRUPTCY PROCEDURE, APPROVING EMPLOYEE SEVERANCE PAYMENTS AND CERTAIN ADDITIONAL EMPLOYEE RELATED RELIEF

Upon consideration of the motion (the "Motion")² of the Debtors for the entry of an order, pursuant to sections 105(a), 363, and 503 of the Bankruptcy Code, and Rule 9019 of the Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure, (a) retroactively approving the Severance Payments, (b) authorizing (but not directing) the Debtors to issue the Held Checks,³ (c) authorizing (but not directing) the Debtors to make Ordinary Course Severance Payments and enter into applicable severance agreements, (d) retroactively approving the Overpayments, (e) authorizing the Prepetition Severance Obligations, and (f) granting related relief; and it appearing that the Court has jurisdiction to consider the Motion pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §§ 1334(b) and 157, and the Amended Standing Order of Reference from the United States District Court for the District of

The last four digits of Woodbridge Group of Companies, LLC's federal tax identification number are 3603. The Negotiated Severance Payments and the Held Check for Peter DeRienzo were removed from the authorization and approval sought in the Motion based on the informal objection of the Securities and Exchange Commission. Amended exhibits reflecting this change are attached hereto as Exhibits I through III to this Order and are redacted pursuant to the Debtors' motion to file exhibits under seal [D.I. 667].

Delaware dated as of February 29, 2012; and it appearing that venue of the Chapter 11 Cases and the Motion in this district is proper pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §§ 1408 and 1409; and it appearing that this matter is a core proceeding pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 157(b); and it appearing that this Court may enter a final order consistent with Article III of the United States Constitution; and it appearing that notice of the Motion has been given as set forth in the Motion and that such notice is adequate under the circumstances and no other or further notice need be given; and the Court having found and determined that the relief sought in the Motion is in the best interests of the Debtors, their estates, their creditors, and all other parties in interest; and that the legal and factual bases set forth in the Motion establish just cause for the relief granted herein; and after due deliberation and sufficient cause appearing therefor,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED THAT:

- 1. The Motion is GRANTED.
- 2. The Severance Payments are retroactively approved and the Debtors are authorized, but not directed, to pay or honor the Severance Payments and to pay, release, and honor the Held Checks, as set forth on Exhibit I attached hereto.
- 3. The Debtors are authorized, but not directed, to negotiate, pay and honor Ordinary Course Severance Payments and enter into applicable severance or other agreements related thereto whereby such employee releases the Debtors and their estates from all claims and obligations, each in an amount to include at least the value of approximately 60 days' wages and benefits, *provided that*:
 - a. the Debtors shall provide the U.S. Trustee, the Committee, the Noteholder Group, the Unitholder Group, and the SEC (the "Notice Parties") with notice of the Debtors' intent to make Ordinary Course Severance Payments ("Notice"), which shall identify the applicable employee's name, title, annual salary, and the proposed amount of the Ordinary Course Severance Payment;

- b. the Notice Parties shall have through 5:00 p.m. prevailing Eastern Time on the fifth business day after receipt of Notice to notify the Debtors in writing, which may be by electronic mail, of any issues or objections ("Objection") with respect to the payment of any Ordinary Course Severance Payment;
- c. if the Notice Parties do not timely notify the Debtors of any Objection, or if the Notice Parties consent to the payment of a proposed Ordinary Course Severance Payment prior to the expiration of the Notice period, the Debtors may pay the respective Ordinary Course Severance Payment, subject to the terms of this Order; and
- d. if the Notice Parties timely notify the Debtors of an Objection, the Debtors shall not pay such Ordinary Course Payment without further order of this Court or the consent of the Notice Parties; provided, however, that the Debtors may pay any other Ordinary Course Severance Payment that is not the subject of an Objection.
- 4. The Settlements are in the best interests of the Debtors, their estates, their creditors, the Committee, and all other parties in interest; the legal and factual bases of the Motion establish just cause for the relief granted hereby; and, pursuant to Rule 9019, the Settlements are approved. The Settlements were a fair resolution of any Claims against the Debtors' estate in exchange for monetary consideration and represent a full and final compromise of any and all Claims against the Debtors' estate. In addition, on a go-forward basis, any Settlement shall include, as a condition of settlement, a representation by the employee that s/he is not an "insider."
- 5. The Overpayments are retroactively approved and the Debtors are authorized, but not directed, to pay or honor the Overpayments, as set forth in Exhibit II attached hereto.
- 6. The Pre-Petition Severance Obligations are approved and the Debtors are authorized, but not directed, to pay or honor the Pre-Petition Severance Obligations, as set forth

in <u>Exhibit III</u> attached hereto, to the extent that such payments do not exceed the Priority Cap for any individual employee.

- 7. The Debtors' banks and financial institutions are authorized to honor checks, electronic payment requests, and wire transfers related to the Severance Payments, Held Checks, Ordinary Course Severance Payments, Overpayments and Pre-Petition Severance Obligations, and to reissue any check or electronic payment request that is not cleared by the applicable bank or other financial institution, to the extent necessary.
- 8. Nothing in the Motion or this Order, nor as a result of any payment made pursuant to this Order, shall be deemed or construed as an admission as to the validity or priority of any claim against the Debtors, a waiver of the Debtors' rights to dispute any claim, an approval or assumption of any agreement, contract or lease pursuant to Bankruptcy Code section 365, or shall impair the ability of the Debtors, or any other party in interest, to the extent applicable, to contest the validity and amount of any payment made pursuant to this Order or otherwise, including, but not limited to any transactions related to the Non-Debtor Affiliate Payments, Precise Investment Group, LLC, Brett Pittsenbargar, insider transactions, the Negotiated Severance Payments, and the Rehired Contractors.
- 9. Nothing in this Order, or in the authorization of any payment under this Order, will restrict, limit or impair any rights or claims of the SEC, including, without limitation, any enforcement or collection rights against the recipient of any payments authorized under this Order.

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10. This Court shall retain jurisdiction with respect to all matters relating to the implementation or interpretation of this order.
